

Welcome to Zeebrugge

Public transport

This shuttle bus will bring you safely from your ship's gangway to a safe zone at the Zeebrugge marina just outside the cruise terminal. From this central point we invite you to discover our region in the way that suits you best.

The medieval marvel of Bruges is just 15 minutes away by train, coastal towns like Blankenberge, Knokke or Ostend can be easily reached by tram. Taxi's will take you anywhere you want to go but perhaps you just prefer strolling in Zeebrugge for a few hours. Why not enjoy the local gastronomy in the marina or beach area ?

The map inside contains all essential information for visitors that want to make their own choices.

Belgium is known for its strong network of public transport. All the important coastal towns are connected by a single tram line. Train connections to inland destinations are offered from either the station(s) of Zeebrugge or the station of nearby Heist.

Tram:

- every 15 minutes a tram passes by the tram stop 'Zeebrugge Kerk' just opposite the church;
- to Blankenberge (10 minutes) and Ostend (45 minutes) in the direction of De Panne;
- to Knokke (15 minutes) in the other direction.

Train from Zeebrugge direct to Bruges (20 minutes):

- On weekdays (except during July and August) the railway station *Zeebrugge Village* offers hourly connections to Bruges as of 7.06 a.m. The return train from Bruges leaves the city hourly at 34 minutes past the hour.
- On weekdays in July and August the railway station *Zeebrugge Beach* offers hourly connections to Bruges as of 08.06 a.m. The return train leaves the city at 34 minutes past the hour.
- During weekends the railway station *Zeebrugge Beach* offers connections to Bruges as of 08.06 a.m. every 2 hours. The return train from Bruges leaves the city every 2 hours 34 minutes past the hour.

Train from Heist or Blankenberge direct to Bruges (15 minutes):

- During July and August both railway stations offer connections to and from Bruges every half hour.
- From September through June both railway stations offer connections to Bruges every hour with trains leaving as from 07.43 a.m. The return train leaves Bruges hourly at 02 minutes past the hour.
